We started with juicy tiger prawn cutlets marinated in asafoetida, carom seeds and yoghurt, \$19, and the Posh platter of chicken tikka, lamb cutlets, koliwada rolls, and onion bhajia, \$22. Each tasty morsel was loaded with flavour. The stir-fried mushroom and peas, \$13, and Punjabi home-style chicken curry, \$17, we chose for mains were equally delicious. Although, I have to admit, the next table ordered a dosa filled with spicy potatoes, \$13, and if it wasn't for the opportunity to gyrate alongside the Bollywood dancer, I would've joined them.
